Fastest MIDI Interface

Fastest Interface Ever

IMPORTANT NOTE: Adjust GI-20 sensitivity first:

- 1) **Rotate the PARAMETER Knob clockwise one step to GUITAR SEL.**
- 2) **Press the SELECT (EXIT) Button.**
- 3) **Play each string hard. You will see from one to five LEDs light up at the top of the display. When 5 lights show only at the hardest attack on each string, Sensitivity is correct.**
- 4) **Press PATCH/VALUE UP/DOWN Buttons to adjust string sensitivity.**
- 5) **Turn the PARAMETER Knob to PLAY.**

To Show Tracking Speed

- 1) **Connect the GI-20 to a sound module.**
- 2) **Rotate the PARAMETER Knob to MIDI CHANNEL MONO/POLY MODE.**
- 3) **Press the PATCH/VALUE UP/DOWN Buttons to select PL (Poly).**
- 4) **Select a sound with fast response, such as organ, nylon guitar or other.**
- 5) **Play sweeps, trills or fast runs.**

MIDI and USB MIDI Outs

If Connected to a Computer with MIDI software:

- 1) **Press the SELECT/USB Button to light the LED and switch MIDI to computer and back to MIDI sound module.**
- 2) **Press the Select Button again to switch MIDI directly to sound module.**

Guitar Output

- 1) **Connect a guitar cord to the GUITAR OUPUT of the GI-20.**
- 2) **Connect the cord to a guitar processor or amp.**
- 3) **Use the switch on the guitar to select synth, guitar or both.**
