How Do I Change My Tuning Reference?

Use the following procedure to change the TU-2's reference pitch standard:

- 1 With the TU-2 powered on, press **STREAM/CENT** and **MODE** simultaneously—the current pitch value flashes.
- 2 Release **STREAM/CENT** and **MODE**, and while the value is still flashing, press the **MODE** button repeatedly to select the desired pitch setting from 0 to 9.
 - 0—440
 - 1—441
 - 2—442
 - 3—443
 - 4—444
 - 5—445
 - 8—438
 - 9—439

Note: When the TU-2's power is turned off, the pitch is re-set back to standard concert pitch, or 440.

WHY DOES THE DISPLAY SHOW NUMBERS INSTEAD OF LETTERS?

If the TU-2's display shows numbers instead of letters, it's in Guitar or Bass tuning mode. If you wish to have the TU-2's display show letters as you tune so you know what note you're playing, set the TU-2 to Chromatic mode.

To change modes, tap the MODE button until the LED above the desired mode's name is lit. For Chromatic mode, press MODE repeatedly until the LED above "CHROMATIC" lights.

HOW CAN I SET WHAT'S HEARD AS I TUNE?

The TU-2 provides two output jacks that allow you to control what's heard while you're tuning:

- *To continue to hear your instrument as you tune*—connect the TU-2's BYPASS jack to your amp or mixer.
- *To silence your instrument output as you tune*—connect the TU-2's OUTPUT jack to your amp or mixer.
